

OKRA GOALS FOR 2014

- 1. Meet revenue projections
- 2. Attain 501c3 status
- Continue to work with national recycling organizations. Current members of NRC/Keep America Beautiful & RONA
- 4. Sponsor a statewide PSA contest for high school students for America Recycled Day
- 5. Continue to work with SWANA & build working relationship
- 6. Review By-laws & make necessary changes
- 7. Review financial compliance & receive outside audit if deemed necessary by board.
- 8. Publish membership directory & distribute or allow online access to members.
- 9. Promote OKRA membership at least 12 events
- 10. To strive for a successful annual conference, by having at least 150 participants, at minimum breakeven and keep the conference affordable to all who would like to participate.
- 11. Publish at least 4 OKRA newsletters.
- 12. Establish email distribution list specifically for elected officials to send the newsletter and event invitations to.
- 13. Retain 90% of members from 2013 and increase to 140 members
